

## **GM Tim Says:**

### **July 16 – BCG Online Tee Time System (WebRes) is “in the works”**

However your ability to use it is entirely based upon the ProShop having an accurate email address for you in our system. It has come to our attention that the current golf database is outdated, flawed and inaccurate. ### **June 7 – Hole 17 Drop Area**

Last year the Golf Committee in conjunction with the Pro staff modified the red tee drop area from an area across the hazard toward the green to the end of the peninsula to the left of the fairway that juts into the hazard. This change was made after Brian Meglio, our Head Golf Professional, at the request of the Golf Committee contacted the VSGA and the USGA. Both confirmed that for a drop zone to be legal the competitor must have to hit a shot that requires negotiation of a portion of the hazard. The new drop zone meets that requirement while reducing the forced carry by about 50 yards to reach the second fairway over that required from the 17<sup>th</sup> fairway. The distance from the center of the drop area to the center of the green is 118 yds.

Because the peninsula contains a right-of-way for a PWC sewer line, powered carts are not allowed to proceed to the drop area. The drop area is a non-irrigated portion of the course and is mowed neither with the frequency nor to the height of the tees or fairways. If mowed to shorter fairway height there would not be much grass there by the end of the summer. This drop area is optional and is available for the use of all golfers.
